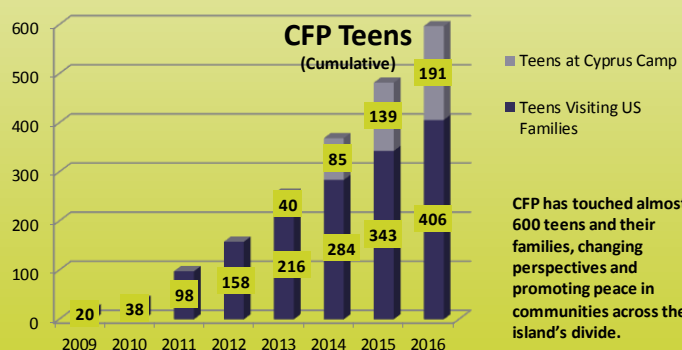
It was an experience that will never fade away from our brains. We have a sibling from 'the enemy' and that won't go away.
